



# RIVERSIDE REPORTER: APRIL 2022

Every year as we approach Holy Week, I find myself noticing new details in the story of Jesus' death and resurrection. This year (perhaps because our theme is 'Lent in the little things') I've been wondering about very small details: Were there splinters in the cross? How heavy was the hammer? When Jesus knelt to pray in Gethsemane, was the ground carpeted with leaves or was he kneeling in roots and bare earth? (In other words: **did our savior die with his knees dirty from the very world he came to save?**)

I can only guess at these questions (e.g. I highly doubt that the Roman Empire took time to smooth down their instruments of execution, so yes, splinters seem likely); the tiny unknowns wouldn't change the huge hope of the Gospel story. In many ways, they are inconsequential. But also: little details make things real for us. When grieving a loved one, we miss the little things—the smell of their hair or the crinkle that appeared in their forehead every time they laughed. When Maddie was born and we were leaving the hospital, I clearly remember the \*click\* of the carseat. *"This just got real."* I thought. "We are responsible for this little life."

It's the same for our faith and life in Christ: the details make it real.

We want the Holy Week story (the Jesus story) to shape and cover every little detail of our lives. Because God's grief and love for our world (for us) is very very real. Knees-covered-in-dirt kind of real. Your-burdens-are-known-and-the-stone-is-rolled-away kind of real.

Jesus shows us the details of God's love made real.  
So come and worship. Come and see.

## Board of Trustees Update

Hello Church Family!

Just a quick update from your friendly Trustees. Room 305 has been transformed from a disappointing shell of its former self into a friendly and inviting room that is suitable for any purpose. It is matched to the hallway with blue carpeting and the same color of paint as the hallway. Room 305 will be left open the next couple of Sundays, so please feel free to stop by and take a gander. It is our purpose to ensure the facilities are the best that we can make them so that all of us can gather to worship, learn the Word and to provide opportunities for fellowship.

A further bit to the update is that we have identified several areas where repairs need to be accomplished on the Sanctuary, McChord Bldg and Education Bldg. Both the Sanctuary and McChord buildings have water seeping through the brick facing and gutters and downspouts are in a condition that repairs and/or replacement will be needed. Roof over McChord building needs to be resealed and all of the smaller entrance roofs around all buildings need the same care. The rooftop air conditioners over the Education building are significantly past their service life. (Eleven units, four have been replaced in last few years, the others were installed in 1993). This is a major facilities upgrade and we have had two general contractors do a walkthrough of all three buildings. We have received an initial quote from one of the GCs and are waiting for the second. Further updates will be provided as Trustees and Church Council work through this process.
