# Family Promise Week Follow-Up

Hello Congregation,

We hosted about 13 people from Family Promise, ranging from infant through adult over September 24-October 1, 2023.

We as a congregation and coordinator had to pivot at the last minute and adjust how we would serve the families. We learned at the last minute that the working adults didn't have the normal 9-5 employment, with that it just wasn't in the best interest of the families and volunteers to host them (overnight stays) at RPUMC. As a host congregation, we want to meet the families where they are, meaning making life a little smoother.

As a congregation (community), we provided meals to the families at the Family Promise headquarters, which was greatly appreciated. I know several people went through the afternoon-early evening rainstorms to get that meal to them and on time, and for that-Thank You.

I had the opportunity to sit with the families and share a meal. They were very engaging and grateful. During the meal I shared with them, we had a blessing where we all held hands and formed a very large circle while a school-aged child led the blessing. She spoke so eloquently about when we are down, we aren't out and we don't give up- we keep praying and believing (Paraphrasing the child). It was moving to hear a child speak so maturely in her testimony.

I invited these families to Sunday School, Worship and our upcoming Trunk or Treat and extended our prayers as a community to them.

Moving Forward, I will be working with Family Promise to schedule a de-brief/training so please watch for that.

For 2024, we will plan for 2 individual weeks as a host congregation. Please keep in mind that Covid has changed the Family Promise original operating model. It definitely is not how we are used to Family Promise operating. We, as a congregation/Community must shift with Family Promise, which we did seamlessly without hesitation.
